### ***Special Canada Day Service:***

#### ***FREE Canada Day Shuttle***

Winnipeg Transit will be operating a FREE Canada Day Shuttle linking Downtown, The Forks and Osborne Village. The FREE shuttle service begins at 12:00 p.m. and runs until 12:00 a.m.

#### ***11 Portage Extra Service***

Winnipeg Transit will be operating EXTRA bus service on Route 11 Portage for travel between The Forks and Assiniboine Park. The EXTRA service begins at 12:00 p.m. and runs until 11:00 p.m.

Regular transit fares apply.

***Post-Fireworks: (Departure)***

Leaving The Forks: Buses to all parts of the city will be available northbound on Main Street at York.

Leaving Assiniboine Park: Extra buses will be parked eastbound Portage at Overdale to take passengers downtown. 2 extra buses will be parked westbound Portage at Overdale to provide service to the St. James Assiniboia area.
