- **Songbird Banding - daily 10 a.m. to noon (weather permitting)** - View songbird banding with the resident naturalist and see these birds up close as you learn to identify them.
- **Horse-drawn Wagon Rides - daily 12:30 to 4:30 p.m.** - Explore some lesser known part of the marsh with Allan Webb and his horse-drawn wagon. Extra fee of \$4 for non-members of the Interpretive Centre and \$2 for members apply for this half-hour to forty-five minute ride.
